Irwell 2 This week Irwell 2 have enjoyed joining in lots of end of term activities and celebrations whilst getting ready for our

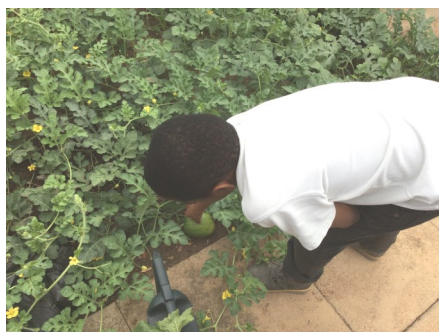


Summer holidays.
