
MILLWOOD DAY—Friday 27 April

flower grows the tallest. We really enjoyed feeling the seeds and the compost.




Redvales 2 We have had a lovely first

Irwell 4 It's been all about History in Irwell 4 this week! We have been looking at




'old' and 'new' clothing and trying to guess whether they were from a long time ago or in the present. Ava knew that the
